# Kislingbury Parish Council

## Notes from the meeting held on Tuesday 21st December

**Precept** The Parish Council has had to make some particularly difficult decisions this year about how your money should be spent in the 2011/2012 period. Some items of expenditure, such as local elections and updating street lights, have been legally forced upon us, while other items, such as conservation of the village greens, are a necessity. Some outgoings will be one-off payments, while others will be spread over a number of years and to offset some of these, we have had to 'Rob Peter to Pay Paul'! Below are some of the major items.

**Street Lights** The EU has decreed that all White Mercury Vapour lanterns must be replaced by white or yellow Sox lanterns, and all concrete poles must be replaced by galvanised steel columns, by the year 2015. The total cost for these works, at current prices, will be £7,817.36 so we have budgeted £2,200.00 for the first year.

**Local Elections** will cost in the region of £1,500.00, but this will be for one year only.

**Village Green** The erosion of the village green, adjacent to the diagonal road between the Bugbrooke Road and Church Lane, has been of major concern for many years and it is now so bad that, if left, we are in danger of losing about one metre on each side of the road. The Parish Council has agreed that, in order to preserve our village green, granite kerbstones should be put on either side of the road and the green reinstated. We have been told that NCC Highways will **not** be able to pay for this work so the Parish Council, after much deliberation, took the difficult decision that the cost should come out of next years precept. We have therefore budgeted for £8,000.00 to pay for this work to be carried out. This will be a one off payment because the cost cannot be spread over a number of years.

**Grass Mowing** £5,000.00.

**Village Maintenance** £2,000.00. This includes emptying Dog Waste Bins, which this year will have cost in excess of £1,400.00.

**Annual Grants** The grant of £1,800 to the Village Hall and the £200.00 to Kislingbury News has been withdrawn and the KPFA grant of £1,500.00 has been reduced. These annual grants will be subject to review in the 2012/2013 financial year.

After much deliberation, the Parish Council decided to increase the precept for 2011/2012 from £19,000.00 to £20,000.00.

## Neighbourhood Watch Newsletter

**Village news** - The Village has been quiet over the last month, thankfully. One incident of Vandalism took place in the High Street when the Power Lead to some Christmas Lights was cut in 4 places. This sort of behaviour is very distressing, but one side effect of the cold weather may be that those who do this sort of thing are being kept indoors. The cold temperatures are very dangerous for our elderly and vulnerable residents. If you have neighbours who may be at risk please take time to check on them and make sure that they are alright.

**Local news** - In Bugbrooke Patio Doors were opened using something like a Screwdriver. Passports, Other Documents and a set of Keys were stolen.

I am happy to say that a number of Villagers have requested a FREE Fire Safety Check from the Fire Service, who also have some FREE Smoke Alarms to give away if they feel a house needs them. This offer is still open so I encourage more Villagers to take advantage of the Fire Service expertise to make their homes safer. Please contact me if you wish to have a visit and I will get it arranged.

**SmartWater** - The SmartWater order has now been delivered and those who asked for them are already beginning to enjoy the extra protection that SmartWater brings. I have some kits still available. These will go on a first come first served basis! Please do not think that this is just a fancy name for marker pens. This is a high-tech solution that works to deter crime on two levels. First, thieves do not want to steal goods that have been marked. Second, dealers do not want to handle goods that have been marked. Finally, the success rate for returning marked goods to the owners is very high as the code of the SmartWater that you use is unique to you.

Do you have a couple of hours free once a fortnight to become a home visitor/befriender for Northamptonshire Association for the Blind in your local area. This small time commitment will make a huge difference to a visually impaired person's life. People with a sight impairment often become isolated and lose confidence. A volunteer role within our visiting service will help them regain and retain their independence and well-being.



