# Neighbourhood Plan



Following on from the recent Questionnaire and Meeting on October 18<sup>th</sup> we have rewritten the Goals of your Neighbourhood Plan to better reflect the views that you have expressed. Now these read as follows:

1. To provide existing and future residents with the opportunity to live in a decent home.
2. To minimise the impact of new development on the surrounding countryside, landscape, and ecosystems.
3. To reduce harm to the environment by seeking to minimise pollution.
4. To ensure that Village Community Spirit is enhanced
5. To Reduce Road Traffic Congestion
6. To enhance the prospects for local business enterprise and employment.
7. To maintain the character and vitality of the village.

## **From the Questionnaire which many of you completed – and a big thank you to those that did – here are some of the Main Results**

- 275 people, of all ages, responded to the Questionnaire
- 80% of Respondents accepted that there would need to be a new development in the Village to meet the needs of Residents for small houses that do not cost too much, and for houses for old and vulnerable people.
- Overwhelmingly the view was expressed that the development should be for low cost small family homes.
- A large majority of respondents chose Site D (behind Watts Close) as the site best suited for any new development.
- This choice was also backed up by those who came to the October 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting and expressed a preference.
- 136 people completed the Housing Needs section of the Questionnaire. Of these nearly 30% said that they or someone in their Household would need to move in the next 5 years.
- Nearly 40% of those saying they will need to move said that they wished to remain in Kislingbury.
- Most of these people would like to own their House when they move, but there was also a need expressed for various types of supported Housing.
- More Bungalows was an option that people need when they consider moving. This type of property would allow residents to downsize and stay in the Village.

- Continue with our Consultation meetings

- Begin drafting the Plan


