### Notes from the meeting held on Tuesday 21st June 2011

**Vacancies** Paul Collins was welcomed to his first meeting as a Parish Councillor. Paul has been co-opted to the Council to fill one of the existing vacancies.

**There are still 3 Casual Vacancies left to be filled.**

**Kislingbury Parish Council is entitled to have 9 Councillors.**

**School Crossing Patrol** Last month, the Parish Council received notice from Northamptonshire County Council, that financial support for School Crossing Patrols was being withdrawn. The Members of the Council were very concerned about this and unanimously agreed that we should support Kislingbury Primary School in its efforts to retain the services of the Kislingbury School 'Lollipop Lady'. Following a meeting with the Head Teacher, Mrs Northing, Kislingbury Parish Council voted to grant 'up to £1000.00' to the fund, for the period September 2011 - April 2012. Support in subsequent years would have to be decided on an annual basis at the precept meeting each December, when the annual budget is determined.

**State of the Village** Once again the Council spent a lot of time discussing the general state of the village. The footpaths which criss-cross the village are overgrown with weeds, foliage is over-hanging walls and fences and making life difficult for pedestrians and there is litter everywhere. What can be done about it?

1. Is there a volunteer (or more than one) out there, with time to spare, who would help the Parish Council to keep the village clean and tidy? Who would go around litter picking and pulling out weeds from footpaths? Who would help with a bit of odd jobbing? We do know that one person is already doing some of this, but more would be better! Please have a word with a member of the Council.

2. If every person, young or old, who is able, helped to keep their own street clean and tidy half the battle would be won. If every householder kept the foliage from their own property cut back and confined, another problem would be solved. We would appeal to each and every one of you to do your bit to make our village look like it is a nice place in which to live and a welcoming place to visit.

**Flower Troughs** For the past five years, Miriam and Richard Harris have maintained three out of the four flower troughs which guard the entrances to the village. Peter and Diana Liebscher have lovingly looked after the other one. Now Miriam and Richard have decided it is time to relinquish their responsibilities and the Council is asking for volunteer(s) to take over from them. If you are keen and would like to know what it involves, please contact me or Miriam and we will tell you all about it. Thank you in anticipation. Our heartfelt thanks go to Miriam and Richard who have planted, fed and watered for so long and to Peter and Diana, who are willing to carry on with the good work.



## A Tale from Kislingbury Archives

Taken from The Village Scrapbook - Pubs and Drinking in 1890's

"Kislingbury has had as many as 5 public houses in the past as well as other houses licensed to sell beer - so there is no wonder that there were drunken brawls every Saturday night, and as the cobblers of the village did no work on Mondays but reserved that day for drinking, these 5 pubs were kept busy.

There was a terrible lot of drunkenness 60 years ago mainly at weekends, but they also 'fuddled' on Mondays because of the cobblers. Some men would work hard to get a little money in their pockets and would then knock off work for a week or two, or even a month, and spend all their time at the pubs, rarely being found sober during these drinking bouts. Tarney Watts, Friday Collins and Captin were all regular drunkards and used to fight like anything when drunk. Captin always used to fight his wife, and his mother would always walk with her hand supporting her chin because she had once broken it in a drunken brawl."

## Phenomenal Phenomenon

'You can take the man out of the city, but you can't take the city out of the man'. Is a phrase I seem to have been using quite a bit in recent months for one reason or the other? Nevertheless, I am now in my sixth year in this beautiful part of God's Kingdom and enjoying every minute of it, although a few frustrations still rear their heads on the odd occasion, I find myself a bit of a country file.

This said, when I came to the villages of Bugbrooke, Harpole, Kislingbury and Rothersthorpe after living all my life in the none too prosperous and marginalised parts of towns and cities, I soon found the day to day problems, struggles, financial concerns, relationship issues, searching for peace of mind, etc, etc are still to be found in the villages, they are just to be found behind better front doors.

Recently the Christian Church worldwide as well as here in the villages has celebrated 'Pentecost', that moment in time when God sent his Holy Spirit in power, to all of his Churches for all time, with the promise he would never ever leave us comfortless or alone. The actual event which is described in the first part of the Acts of the Apostles (the second volume of work from one of the Gospel writers Luke) gives a picture of a 'Pronominal Phenomenon' with the full 'Power' and 'Presence' of the Holy Spirit. Even a light reading of history bears witness to the fact the whole course of human history was changed irrevocably by this one event and all our lives are in one way or another is influenced and moulded.

However, one gift the Holy Spirit brings upon his church and all those who wish to respond to his love is 'Peace'. Not a peace which simply means the absence of noise or a peace longed for while nations, countries or individuals are in a state of open, often prolonged conflict. But a peace that passes all understanding, a peace that enables people to live with themselves and those around them, a peace that the world cannot give and a peace on offer to everyone regardless of the quality of the front door.

## **Neighbourhood Watch Newsletter - Kislingbury News July 2011**

**Village news** - I have received very little information since the last Newsletter of any crime or other incidents in the Village (I have not yet received the latest Crime Report so there may be more news in the next Newsletter). We seem to be enjoying a calm time at the moment and all need to be vigilant to keep it so. A planned "Rave" at the Playing Fields in May did not happen due to precautions taken and the strong presence of the Police during the evening. We need to keep our ears open to try to stop these events happening. Any information you may have about parties being organised please tell me or Mike Jackson of the Playing Field Association.

Suspicious Cars were seen one night near the playing fields and when they were aware of the interest in them left immediately. A registration number was passed on to the Police. A white truck supposedly collecting metal was challenged earlier this month and left immediately. The Village was alerted to the presence of the truck and the registration number was passed on to the Police. Our first street meeting with the Police (the new way the Police will interact with the Community) will be held on July 15th at 6pm. at the Car Park near the Toddler Play Area at the Playing Field. The focus will be on Anti-Social Behaviour and the Streets targeted are Hall Close, Beech Lane, The Green, and High Street. But anyone in the Village who would like to raise issues with the Police are welcome, even if you do not live in those Streets.

Hopefully the weather will soon be getting warmer so it is time to remind everyone to be careful about leaving doors and windows open. It only takes seconds for a thief to enter a house, snatch valuables, and be out again, if the windows and doors are not locked. Keep your valuables, house keys, and car keys out of sight of windows or letter flaps as it is easy to "fish" them out. Please also remember that even if a caller to a house appears to be genuine the Police still want to check them. Please call me or the Police on the number shown below to report anyone calling on you without an appointment.
